INFORMATION NOTICE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL (GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION – GDPR)

The Federazione Motociclistica Italiana (FMI), with registered office at Viale Tiziano 70, 00196 Rome (Italy), Tax Code 05277720586 and VAT No. 01383341003, in its capacity as Data Controller (hereinafter, the “Controller”), informs you pursuant to Article 13 of EU Regulation No. 679/2016 (hereinafter, the “Regulation”) that the personal data you voluntarily provide may be subject to processing according to the methods and for the purposes set out below, and in any case, in compliance with the principle of confidentiality that guides the Federation’s activities.

1. Purpose and legal basis of the processing

Your personal data will be processed (for the definition of “processing”, see Art. 4(2) of the Regulation) for the following purposes:

- a) execution of membership activities, including through the online service myfmi.federmoto.it, and the use of functionalities available to members;
- b) execution of activities related to the management of applications and the subsequent issuance of competitive licenses and memberships for upcoming sporting seasons;
- c) organization and management of sports competitions and/or regional, national, and international sporting events, for which personal data such as name, surname, year of birth, motorcycle model, and FMI membership and/or license number are published online on the sigma.federmoto.it federal system, on notice boards (physical or digital), and by other means of communication at event venues, as required by regulations for consultation and verification purposes;
- d) execution of all institutional activities related to membership, including those connected to managing insurance relationships;
- e) handling of requests of any kind submitted to the Federation regarding its areas of competence;
- f) providing responses to requests from data subjects concerning registration in registers, listings, events, competitions, exhibitions, and/or initiatives related to the Federation, and subsequent management thereof;
- g) compliance with:

- legal, regulatory, statutory, and federal obligations, as well as applicable national or international legislation;
- inclusion in federal systems of membership data for the relevant membership category, including registration in federal registers or listings;
- h) sending of advertising, informational, or commercial communications by the Federation;
- i) transfer of data to third parties (e.g., federal sponsors or partners) for the purpose of sending information, including commercial information, about services or future initiatives offered by such third parties.

The legal basis for processing is identified, among others, in the data subject’s consent to the processing of personal data.

2. Personal data subject to processing

2.1 Personal data

Personal data include, for example: name, address, tax code, and other identifying details, including identification documents and your image, and possibly your bank account details (common data). Processing may also include data identifying owned motorcycles, video recordings and/or photographs taken during events organized by the Federation, IP address, and geolocation data from mobile devices when using FMI-owned apps.

2.2 Special categories of personal data (“sensitive data”)

During its activities, the Federation may process special categories of data, such as health data or other information revealing a person’s health status, including for purposes related to national health emergencies.

3. Data retention

Your data will be retained according to the following criteria:

- for no longer than necessary to achieve the purposes for which they were collected;
- for no longer than necessary to comply with legal obligations.

4. Methods of processing

Data processing is carried out using paper and electronic means, with appropriate measures to ensure security and confidentiality and to prevent unauthorized access, loss, or destruction, in accordance with Chapter II (Principles) and Chapter IV (Controller and Processor) of the Regulation. Data may be processed by authorized internal or external personnel bound by confidentiality obligations.

5. Data disclosure and access

Data may also be processed by third-party companies acting as external data processors on behalf of the Controller (e.g., banks, professional firms, suppliers or consultants managing or maintaining electronic or IT systems, insurance companies providing related services).

Your data will only be accessible to individuals who need access due to their role or position. These individuals are instructed to prevent loss, destruction, unauthorized access, or improper use of data.

Without your explicit consent (pursuant to Art. 6(b) and (c) of the Regulation), the Controller may communicate your data to supervisory bodies, judicial authorities, or other entities when required by law.

6. Nature of data provision

Regarding the purposes listed in Section 1 “Purpose and legal basis of processing”:

- For items a) through g), providing your personal data is mandatory;
- For items h) and i), providing your personal data is optional.

Refusal or inaccurate/incomplete provision of data for purposes a)–g) will make it impossible to:

- (a) complete membership registration;
- (b) issue competitive licenses;
- (c) organize and manage competitions or events;
- (d) perform institutional and insurance-related activities;
- (e) process requests submitted to the Federation;
- (f) respond to requests regarding registration or participation in registers, events, or initiatives;
- (g) comply with legal and regulatory obligations and maintain proper registration within federal systems.

Refusal or incomplete provision for purposes (h)–(i) will prevent:

- (h) the sending of advertising, informational, or commercial materials by the Federation;
 - (i) communication of data to third parties for marketing or promotional purposes.

7. Data disclosure

Your data will not be disseminated to unspecified third parties.

8. Data transfer abroad

For purposes strictly related to those described above (e.g., participation in international sporting events and entry procedures for non-EU host countries), your data may be transferred outside the EU.

In such cases, the Controller guarantees that any non-EU transfer will comply with Articles 44 et seq. of the Regulation and applicable laws, including, where necessary, agreements ensuring an adequate level of protection.

9. Data Controller and Data Protection Officer

The Data Controller is the *Federazione Motociclistica Italiana*, Viale Tiziano 70, 00196 Rome (Italy), Tax Code 05277720586, VAT No. 01383341003.

The Federation has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO) pursuant to Article 37 of the Regulation. The DPO can be contacted regarding any data protection issues at privacy@federmoto.it.

10. Rights of the data subject

As a data subject, you are entitled to exercise the rights provided under the Regulation, including:

- a) Right of access (Art. 15): to obtain confirmation whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed and, if so, to access such data and specific information (purposes, categories, recipients, retention period, rights to rectification/deletion/limitation, complaint rights, data source, existence of automated decision-making, etc.).
- b) Other rights (Arts. 16–21): including the right to rectification, erasure (“right to be forgotten”), restriction of processing, data portability, and objection.

The Federation undertakes to respond to your requests within one month from receipt, extendable in complex cases with an explanation provided within that same timeframe. Responses may be provided in writing, either on paper or electronically.
